DEDICATED TO THE 100TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE REPUBLIC OF ESTONIA IN 2018

Are you a young journalist? Would you like to spend one week in August in Estonia learning more about Estonia, Estonian society and the Estonian way of life?

In 2018 our country will celebrate its centenary. Preparations for celebrating the centenary are already under way. Between 2014 and 2018, we are inviting 25 young journalists every summer for the „100 Friends“ study visit.

In 2016, the Estonian Foreign Ministry and the Government Office would like to invite the next 25 young journalists to take part in the study visit “100 Friends” from July 31st to August 7th.

Application requirements:

1. 20-30 years of age
2. Ability to free yourself from work from 31 July -7 August, 2016
3. A citizen or permanent resident of the following countries: Austria, Belgium, China, Czech Republic, Denmark, France, Germany, Greece, Ireland, Italy, Kazakhstan, Latvia, Lithuania, Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Russia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Turkey, United Kingdom, United States.
4. A good knowledge of English and the ability to adapt to a multinational group

The Estonian MFA covers the following costs for the participants:

1. Return airline tickets to Tallinn from your home country (local transport in home country is not included)
2. A single room in a hotel in Tallinn with breakfast and a twin room with breakfast during the trip out of Tallinn

3. Breakfast is provided by the hotel. Lunches and dinners are served according to the programme
4. The daily programme (all events, travel and transportation)

The programme does not cover medical insurance.

Deadlines:

A CV with a photo (Europass CV <http://europass.cedefop.europa.eu/en/documents/curriculum-vitae>) and motivation letter must reach the [Estonian Embassy](#) of your home country by **April 11th**. The interviews will take place in April and the final decisions will be made in May.
